Workplace giving, also known as payroll giving, is a simple and low-cost, yet powerful way to make regular donations to the United Nations Association of Australia. The money is deducted directly from your gross pay as a salary sacrifice. Almost all modern Australian corporate organizations now have a workplace giving program.

Workplace giving enables you to make a difference through regular donations from your pre-tax pay. It can also help your company with their corporate and social responsibility ambitions.

If your company already has a workplace giving program in place and you wish to support the UNAA in this way, contact your human resources department to ask them about joining the workplace giving program and making donations to the UNAA.

If your employer does not have a workplace giving program in place, you could be the one to kick-start the program. Contact your community affairs, corporate social responsibility or human resources department to suggest a workplace giving program be established and for the UNAA to be nominated as a charity partner.
