Join the 2017/18 Executive Committee

How much time will I have to contribute?	15 – 20 hours a month including a monthly 2 hour meeting in Sydney's CBD
Do I have to be a paid member?	Yes, you need to be a fully paid member before 20 July 2017 in order to run for an EC role and/or vote at the 2017/18 AGM.
Do I need previous experience?	No previous board experience is necessary. However, EC members should be passionate about our work and enjoy solid team play to achieve our goals including creating a safer, fairer and more sustainable world.
Who can my Proposer and Seconder be?	Your Proposer and Seconder must be a current financial member of UNAA NSW.
What is the deadline for submitting my Nomination?	Nominations must be received by 20 July 2017.
When will I know if my Nomination is successful?	Shortlisted candidates will be notified by email. Summaries of each candidate will be posted on the UNAA NSW website so members can review and help inform their vote.
Who should I contact if I wish to discuss my Nomination prior to submission?	Please contact Alex Maron or Patricia Jenkings via email <u>nsw.agm@unaa.org.au</u> .
Can I apply for multiple roles?	We don't recommend that you apply for multiple roles. In the first instance we ask that you contact either Alex Maron or Patricia Jenkings via email nsw.agm@unaa.org.au , to discuss your Nomination and advise you on the most suitable option.
How do I apply?	Please complete the Nomination Form and supply a 50 - 250 word summary including your background, skills and experience you will bring .
	Candidates will be invited to present a short introduction at the AGM prior to members voting. Your summary will also be posted on the NSW website and included as a handout at the AGM.
